Departmental reports:

Police Chief Smith was not available to give a report.



Public Works Director Zimbelman reported on several projects. The East side lift station is completed and working. Splash pad project is stalled with cement needing to be redone (see attached report). Alderman Schoenrock noticed some bulbs out on streetlights on Main Street. These will be replaced before the Christmas Stroll.

Library Director Christensen reported good numbers in visits to the library with an increase in digital presence. Need to get a contractor for projects or possibly get an extension. (See full report for details).

Finance Officer Rogers reported on the budget. AFR has been submitted to the State. Waiting on monies from the county to increase the general fund. Investments are good with interest income increasing (see financial report for details).

budgeted at all and needs to be in the \$2,000.00 range. Expenditure lines were overspent and need to have a budget adjustment. More discussion at the next meeting.

### City Council Report Dec 3rd 24

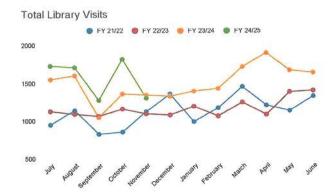
- 1. Finished grading alleys and added gravel where needed.

- 9. New hire is working out well.

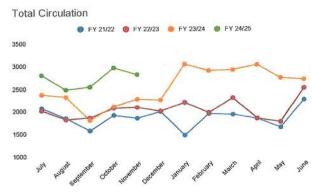

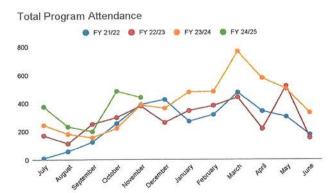
#### **Conrad Public Library Report**

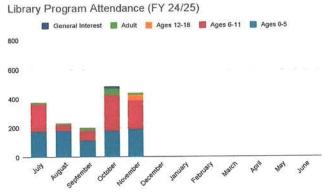
Wednesday, November 6, 2024 @ 6:00 PM [presented to the Conrad City Council]

- November Statistics:
  - o 1,302 library visits (-3.1% from last year)
  - o 2,812 items circulated (+23.8% from last year); 35.4% of circulation was digital
  - o 442 program attendees (+14.2% from last year)
- SLIPA grant contracts from MT Department of Commerce have been completed. Bid requests for
  project contractors will be publicized this week and next week with a submission deadline of the
  20th, to be awarded before the 31st.
- The Library has signed a contract with Hygienix to create an asbestos abatement plan to be implemented as soon as possible; this may have its own bid process.
